

## Green Certification Program 2020 UPCYCLE Challenge

Beginning in 2020, the UPCYCLE Challenge will be held annually. Challenge entries will be judged and a winner selected at the annual Green Certification Banquet. Each year the theme of the challenge will change with the next year's theme being announced during the Banquet.

## 2020 THEME: Create the UPCYCLE trophy that will be given out in future years to challenge winners.

The trophy must:

- Be durable as it will be given to future winners to display
- Include a flat area that is at least 6" x 8" that data plates (similar to the recertification data plates that are provided each year) can affix to. The plates will be provided by the Program.
- Be no larger than 20" tall by 14" wide
- Be made from recycled, reused or repurposed items. The only items that may be purchased new are binding materials (i.e. tape, glue, string, etc.). If you are unsure if your item will be allowed contact the Program prior to use.

Entries will be judged based on the resemblance to a trophy, durability, creativity and originality. In order to be considered the entry must come from a Green Certified organization and that organization must be present at the 2020 Green Certification Banquet.

The winning organization will be the first name added to the trophy and that organization will display the trophy until the 2021 Green Certification Banquet.

Approximately two months prior to the 2020 Green Certification Banquet, an official UPCYCLE entry form will be provided to all Green Certified organizations. The official entry form must be returned at least one week prior to the 2020 Banquet so we may prepare space and dedicate appropriate time to judge the entries during the Banquet. All entries must arrive one hour prior to the Banquet start time. Late entries will not be accepted.

While it is not required, organizations may use the Green Certification logo if they so choose.
